Lots of primary fruit on the nose with blackberry, black pepper and liquorice. Pronounced liquorice black pepper palate. Full bodied.</i>		
15. Rocheburg Pinotage - 2008 13.5%	D	£14.50
<i>Unique to South Africa, this deep rich concentrated wine has depth and firmness. A black cherry nose and palate gives a uniquely delicious flavour.</i>		
16. Azabache Crianza - 2005 14.0%	C	£16.00
<i>RIOJA CRIANZA - Intense, bright garnet red colour with ruby reflections. Complex bouquet of ripe fruits and liquorice, perfectly combined with vanilla from American oak. Smooth, persistent, slightly tannic, long and balanced. A modern style of wine.</i>		
17. Canale Black River Organic Merlot - 2007/08 13.5%	D	£13.50
<i>PATAGONIA - Organic grown grapes, Alto Valle de Rio Negro, Patagonia. Full bodied, it is purple coloured with deep ruby sparkles. Soft tannins. Ripen black plum aromas echoing black pepper notes. A modern style with an excellent finish.</i>

<i>SOUTH EAST AUSTRALIA - Ripe rich mulberry fruit with a touch of spice on the nose. The palate, soft blackberry and mulberry fruits intertwined with vanilla, allspice and gentle tannins.</i>
