- 1 Villa Rosa Unoaked Chardonnay, Colchagua** £10.50
Chile, 2006/07, 13.0%, 2
Light golden Chardonnay with smooth rounded fruit, gaining in richness and expression to a well-made full finish.
- 2 Villa Rosa Sauvignon Blanc, Carico** £10.50
Chile, 2006/07, 13.0%, 1
Lightly floral with a bright line running through it to give a refreshing clean zippy wine.

House Red Wine

- 3 Villa Rosa Merlot, Rapel** £10.50
Chile, 2006/07, 14.5%, C
Ripe fleshy aroma. Succulent and mouth-filling, softening to a velvety finish.
- 4 Villa Rosa Cabernet Sauvignon, Colchagua** £10.50
Chile, 2005/06, 13.5%, C
Open and friendly, with berry fruit and a flash of blackcurrant, it has a nice leafy edge and a touch of oak for added breadth. A light, easy, fruity wine.

- 5 **Château Pierrail Bordeaux Supérieur** £13.00
France, 2006/07, 12.0%, 1
Sauvignon Blanc and Sauvignon Gris together make an easy lifted style, delivered with soft breezy freshness.
- 6 **Chablis , Le Manoir - Burgundy** £19.50
France, 2005/06, 12.5%, 2
Attractive young Chablis with its cool signature style of wet pebbles.
- 7 **San Alessandro Pinot Grigio, Veneto** £13.00
Italy, 2006/07, 12.0%, 2
Light and polished with almost tangible floral notes and a delicate nutty touch.
- 8 **Chardonnay Black Label, McGuigan Brothers** £14.00
S.E. Australia, 2005/06, 13.0%, 2
Lemon-edged, golden, toasty, easy Chardonnay.
- 9 **Riebeeck Chenin Blanc Reserve, Western Cape** £13.50

Dark fruit in a good berry style. Ripe, juicy character with a touch of bramble. Big and spicy in the mouth, easy and open with a warm burst of alcohol on the finish.
- 12 **San Alessandro Primitivo, Puglia** £13.00
Italy, 2004/05, 13.5%, D
The Primitivo grape is the polished wild thing from Southern Italy, giving very good value and guaranteed satisfaction. Masses of black fruit, herbs and a touch of untamed hedgerow.

Spain, 2003/04, 13.5%, C
Instantly attractive combination of vital strawberry fruit and soft oak flavours that is the hallmark of Rioja, and its universal appeal.

S.E. Australia, 2003/04, 13.5%, B
Soft, smooth, open-flavoured, easy drinking red.
